## SEASON PASS CLASSIFICATIONS

Season passes (henceforth “memberships”) are available for families or individuals. A family membership includes the member, the member’s spouse or partner, and individuals in the member’s immediate family living at home up to and including the age of 25. (A single parent with a family membership may count one of the following in the place of his / her spouse: his / her child above the age of 25, or one of his / her children’s grandparents, or a live-in caregiver. If this applies to you, please make note on your application.)

**Club:** Club membership includes all privileges of the Club, including swimming pool, golf and tennis.

**Pool:** Pool membership includes use of the swimming pool, but does not include membership privileges for golf or tennis.

**Garrison Golf:** Garrison is an add-on that offers unlimited golf at Garrison Golf Club and is only available to Club category members.

## GUEST PASSES, ADDITIONAL DESIGNEES & POOL

Members are required to pay for a guest pass in the pro shop for each guest they are bringing to the tennis, golf or swimming pool areas. A guest is not required to pay additional greens fees to play golf. The same individual (if he/she lives within 20 miles of the Club) may be the guest of a member not more than three times in a season. For longer staying house guests, live-in caregivers, non-resident grand-parents and grown children, etc., members may request an Additional Designee by month or for the season. Spouses, members' children under the age of 26, and area residents do not qualify as an Additional Designee. The Club does not offer partial-season or pro-rated memberships.

Young children must be attended by their parents while at the Club. Should a Family member have a nanny or hire a local babysitter to attend to the member's children in his / her absence, there is no additional fee for the babysitter / nanny, but the member must have a pass for the person. When applying for a weekly or seasonal babysitter pass, the member must provide the Club with the names and addresses of the people who will be baby-sitting for them. Baby-sitters and nannies must be with the member's child / children at all times while at the Club and must stay within the pool, clubhouse and tennis areas. Baby-sitters and nannies do not have membership privileges and may sign for food & beverage charges to the member's account only with the written consent of the member. This pass may not be used in the place of a guest pass; i.e., for local or non-resident guests of members. Daily guest and babysitter passes are available in the Pro Shop, as are applications for weekly or seasonal passes, and additional designees.

### Members must stop at the Pro Shop with guests before entering Club areas.

Guest fees must be paid for in the Pro Shop and guests must wear their designated bracelet / have pass on them at all times while on property.

### SWIMMING POOL

The swimming pool at Highlands Country Club is 61' long and 31' wide. The pool is heated and maintained at a temperature of around 76°F - 78°F. Please note that the temperature will sometimes be lower in the morning depending on the overnight ambient temperature. The sunbathing lawn has space for around 30 lounge chairs. There are several umbrellas to provide shade, and Members are welcome to bring their own umbrellas to attach to their lounge chair, if needed. A kiddie pool and children's play set are at the opposite end of the sunbathing area from the swimming pool. There is a staircase from the swimming pool to the basement locker rooms.

### 2018 Pool Schedule

The pool will open Memorial Day weekend: Saturday, May 26, Sunday, May 27, and Monday, May 28. It will be open weekends only until Wednesday, June 20, when it will begin to be open daily through Labor Day. The pool is open Monday - Friday from 11am-8pm, and Saturday and Sunday from 10am-8pm. All members, as well as guests who are utilizing the pool must sign in on the sheet located at the Lifeguard station. A lap lane is available at any desired time within the hours of the pool. You must reserve your requested time on the sign-in sheet at the Lifeguard station.

Private Lessons:      1 hour - **\$50.00**                      1/2 hour - **\$30.00**

To book a lesson: find an available lifeguard; pay for desired length of lesson in the pro shop; bring receipt to lifeguard.

The 9-hole golf course at Highlands Country Club is played from two sets of tees for an approximate total of 4,600 yards. Located across the river from West Point, we offer beautiful views of the Hudson Highlands. The course is perfect for beginners, seniors or walkers, yet still challenging for the experienced golfer. All holes have tee signs. A member league is held on Thursday nights. Beginner lessons are available by request.

*Golf season: early-April to late-October (weather dependent)*

Our Pro Shop stocks most anything you might need for your round, as well as complimentary coffee for golfers. In spring and fall, the course is open to the public 7 days a week. From Memorial Day through Labor Day, the course is open to members only until 1pm on Saturdays and Sundays, and closed to the public on holidays. The course is also closed to the public Thursday evenings beginning at 4:00pm for the member league.

Members of the Club do not pay greens fees.

Fivesomes are NOT allowed (by members or non-members), unless approval is granted in advance by the golf pro shop staff. Children of any age may play golf with their parents. Please keep up the pace or let faster players play through. There are no designated times for children to play or not to play, although they must be at least 13/14 to play without a guardian according to the bylaws.

We have two family golf carts available for 3 or 4 people. These are available on a first come basis throughout the season. For safety reasons, the policy of two people maximum per regular cart will be strictly enforced by the pro shop staff.

#### TENNIS

Highlands Country Club has four Har-Tru tennis courts and one hard surface tennis court with a backboard. The hard court opens in late March/ early April, depending on the weather, the Har-Tru courts in early May. Court time usage during the week is on a first-come, first-served basis. Members may reserve a court for the weekend beginning on Friday at 9am. However, only one member reservation per day at a time is allowed. For example, a member may reserve a court to play on Saturday, beginning Friday at 9am, and then must wait until Saturday to reserve a court for Sunday. Please call Martha at 845-476-0380 or email at [tennispro@highlandscountryclub.net](mailto:tennispro@highlandscountryclub.net) to reserve a court.

An adult (parent, nanny, etc.) may reserve the sport court for play with a young child at any time, or may reserve the hard court as long as there are no lessons or other scheduled play.

Lessons:      1 hour - **\$70.00**                      1/2 hour - **\$35.00**

To book a lesson: pay for desired length in the pro shop; bring receipt to tennis pro.

**Only Club category of membership is eligible for tennis lessons. Pool memberships do not have access to the tennis courts or tennis lessons. There will be a few clinics offered to pool members as an introductory to tennis. You can upgrade your category at any time.**

#### TENNIS CLINICS

*Running from June to August*

##### **Junior Clinics**

**Cost: \$25.00/hr**

##### **“Bronze” beginner ages 4 - 7, Tuesdays @ 4:00pm**

Objective: To introduce these children to the game of tennis in a fun and rewarding way. Our goal is to bring more players into the sport of tennis, to have fun and be around other children who are also learning a new sport.

##### **“Silver” intermediate ages 7- 11, Tuesdays @ 5:00pm**

Objective: To introduce these children to the basics of the game but will also fine tune the strokes to enhance greater production. The program will cover basic strokes: forehand, backhand, volley and the serve.

##### **“Gold” advanced ages 10-18, Tuesdays @6:00pm**

Objective: This is a group that is still working on stroke production and strategy. The student will start developing their own style of play and will begin to use it in competitive situations. “GOLD” will be encouraged to participate on the junior high and high school teams, and local tournaments.

##### **Adult Clinics**

**Cost: \$25.00/hr**

**Open Clinics: Tues @ 10:00am, Wed @ 6:00pm & Fri @ 10:00am**

#### OTHER RECREATION AREAS

A sport court adjoins the tennis area and is equipped with a basketball net and rebound net for dodge ball, etc. A children’s craft table is available by the pool, under a shaded awning on weekends during pool hours with various crafts and activities for kids.

## FOOD, MEMBER TERRACE & EVENTS

### FOOD & BEVERAGE

**\*\*MEMBERS MUST ALWAYS SIGN THEIR CHITS WHEN MAKING ANY PURCHASES AT THE CLUB.\*\***

A menu is available for members. The financial feasibility of providing food and beverage service to members depends largely on the support of members. Therefore, members may not bring food and beverage from outside the Club during menu service hours. Members are not required to spend a “food and beverage minimum”.

The menu is available weekends only beginning Memorial Day weekend. From June 20th through Labor Day Sept. 3rd, the menu is available Wednesdays from 11:30am – 7:30pm (Family Day), and Thursdays – Sundays from 11:30am-4pm.

### MEMBER TERRACE

The Member Terrace has been created to provide a dedicated space for the use of all members. It has been designed for and is intended to be used primarily by members with their families, or small groups of members for dining or socializing. The Member Terrace may be used by HCC members with their accompanying guests only, on a first come, first served basis. A member or group of members may have up to 3 non-member guests when using the Member Terrace. If you have a greater number of guests, please move to the non-member area (under the awning adjacent to the pro shop).

The Member Terrace is available for any member to use, and is not available for exclusive use by any one group of members. For instance, if a group of 10 or 20 members (say, a group of tennis members, or pool members, or golf members) has ordered pizza or is using the BBQ, the Terrace is still available for use by other members.

Groups of members and guests that exceed 20 people are encouraged to also use the non-member portion of the terrace when the club is busy so that there is room for other members and they feel welcome.

The Member Terrace may not be booked in advance by anyone for private gatherings, even if the gathering is made up of members only. For private gatherings, a variety of private spaces are available for booking at HCC and The Garrison.

The BBQ is available for use by members on a first come, first serve basis at the following times:

Monday, Tuesday & Holidays	all day
Wednesday	after 7:30pm
All other days	after 4:00pm

After using the BBQ, *members must clean* the BBQ and BBQ area, including utensils and refrigerator, and remove any trash.
